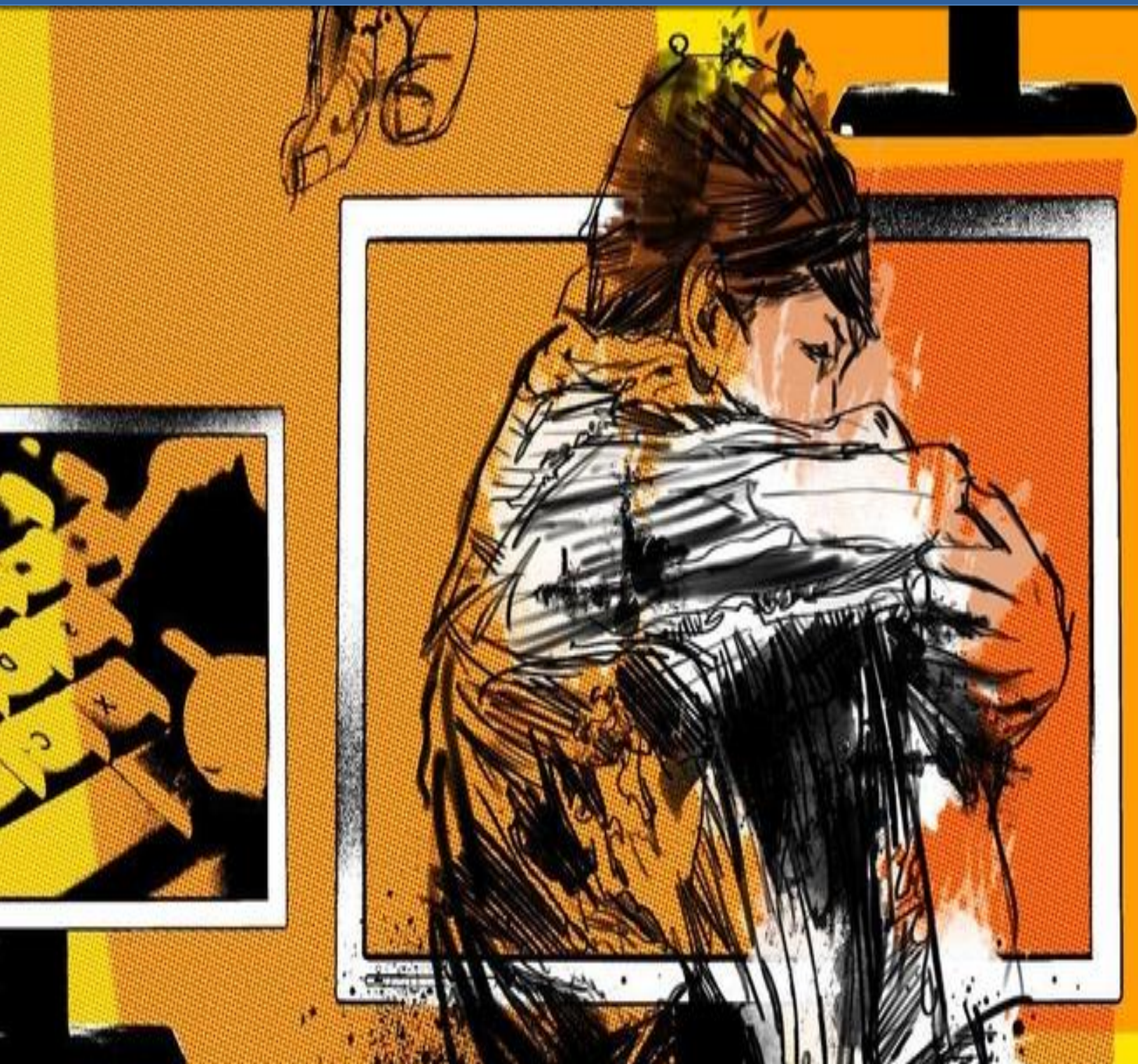

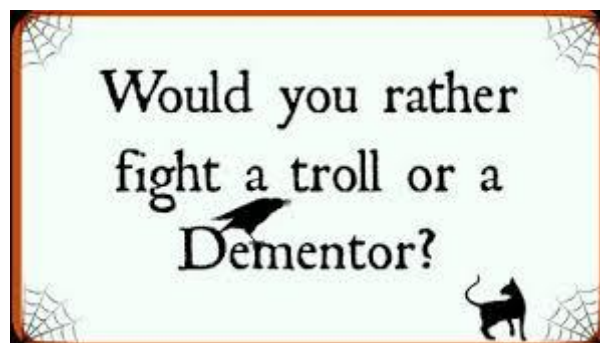
Lesson Plan Objective: Overview of the aspect of cyberbullying called “trolling” and practical tools to combat trolling behavior on the internet. Time: 30 minutes and additional day for poster design

Cyberbullying: How to Deal with Trolls on the Internet

- I. If the group is small, you can discuss directly, or break into small groups and talk about instances of cyberbullying and specifically trolling that they have encountered on the internet. What happened? What website were you? Without repeating profanity, what did he/she say to you? How did you handle it?
- II. Have a few people share their experiences with the whole group.
- III. FlowVella slide presentation: “Cyberbullying: How to Deal with Trolls on the Internet” Discuss what each slide means and allow students to talk through their experiences and knowledge. Watch videos and listen to podcasts either in class or at home.
- IV. On overhead projector model using Pinterest (or other social website) how to:
 1. Use privacy settings
 2. Use community reporting tools
 3. Take screenshots
